Dr. Fero believes strongly in giving back to the community and serves on the advisory boards of the Strike 3 Foundation and the Greater New Haven Leadership Center. In 2013 he was recognized as a Business New Haven Rising Star.

Dr. Fero's recent book, *Lead Me Out to the Ballgame: Stories and Strategies to Develop Major League Leadership* is based on over 100 interviews with Major League Baseball managers, players, and executives, and offers direction for people in all professions to develop and practice Major League Leadership.

The keynotes and workshops presented, whether based on Major League Leadership, or focused on leadership, motivation, or team building in general, are all highly engaging, inspiring, and interactive. Participants leave Howard's sessions feeling empowered to apply the principles brought forth to their lives, both personally and professionally.
